Situated centrally in western Europe, Bitburg's location close to the borders of France, Belgium, the Netherlands and Luxembourg makes this an ideal venue for the 4th AviationExpo Europe's Festival of Aviation.

Within a radius of 320 kms (200 miles) and a 2.5 hours drive from Bitburg, 73,000 pilots fly 14,000 General Aviation aircraft (Business Jets, Turboprops, Piston, Light Sport and Helicopters), in this most affluent part of Europe.

AviationExpo Europe will provide the largest and most exciting event yet, that will attract new and existing clients from this large and active region. Bitburg's 3,056 metre long (10,030 feet) tarmac runway and surrounding apron, will have the space and facilities to allow us to be creative and forward-thinking.

○ Live Demo Flights

Throughout the 3-days of the event, Aircraft Manufacturers and their Agents may demonstrate the capabilities of their aircraft over the airfield for all there to see. Other exhibiting companies such as those in avionics may wish to take potential clients for demo flights. This can be done as often as they wish in flights that will be carried out away from the airfield circuit.

○ Networking Parties

Visiting Pilots and Exhibitors will be encouraged to stay to enjoy the post-show Hangar Party from 17.30-21.00hrs on the 27th and 28th at "Paddy's Bar". This will provide an excellent evening networking opportunity.



The Airport facility has a large indoor exhibition space alongside an extensive tarmac apron offering plenty of hard-static display area. An excellent 3,056 metres tarmac runway is ideal for any type of aircraft. There will be unlimited parking for aircraft and exhibitor's vehicles.

○ **Indoor Exhibition Space**

The two Exhibition Halls each have 3,285 square metres of floor space. They are adjacent to the static display tarmac area for new aircraft.

○ **New & Pre-Owned Aircraft Static Display**


The largest static display area that we have ever provided next to the Exhibition Halls will include new aircraft from manufacturers of Business Jets, Turboprops, Piston, Light Sport and Helicopters. Also adjacent to the New Aircraft we will create Europe's Pre-Owned Aircraft Park including similar aircraft types.

○ **Seminar Building and Catering Area**

Positioned next to Exhibition Hall is the Seminar Building which will be used by leading aviation experts to audiences throughout the 3-days. The Catering area is between both Halls.

○ **Party Hangar and Visitor Centre**

The Party Hangar or "Paddy's Bar", is where the evening Networking Parties will be based from 17.30hrs until 21.00hrs on the 27th and 28th. The International Visitor Centre is a relaxing area next to the Party Hangar.

INSIGNIA OF THE 36th FIGHTER WING U.S. AIR FORCE


Bitburg Air Base was a NATO base and the home of the US Air Force 36th Fighter Wing between 1952-1994. It is located 2 miles (3 kms) south-east of Bitburg, 20 miles (32 kms) north of Trier, and 135 miles (217 kms) west of Wiesbaden.

Construction of the airbase began in western Germany's Eifel mountains in

Rheinland Pfalz in 1951. The 36th Fighter Wing was the first European wing of the US Air Force to receive the latest aircraft, the F4 Phantom and F15 Eagle being famous examples.

Bitburg Airbase was where Neil Armstrong, the first man on the moon, began his career as a pilot. In May 1985, US President Ronald Reagan visited the airbase to mark the 40th anniversary of V-E Day. On 1st October 1994 it was handed over to the German government.

Welcome to Bitburg and the Eifel Region





Enjoy Bitburg - the small town in the Eifel on the German side of the border to Belgium and Luxembourg and not far from France and the Netherlands.

Bitburg is located in the green heart of Europe, full of scenic beauty, historical, cultural and geological wealth. The Eifel region is framed by landscapes carved by the rivers Rhine and Moselle, bordered in the north-west by the Ardennes forest.

Close to Bitburg in the historic Eifel, you can find ancient standing stones (menhirs), Celtic walls, Roman villas, Medieval monasteries and picture-book castles. A further attraction only 32kms away is the city of Trier, the oldest town in Germany founded by the Romans around 16BC. Highlights are

the Porta Nigra, the famous Roman gate, the Emperor's thermal baths and the 20,000 seat amphitheatre.

However, it not only the historical past that is so special about this region. It is a geological walk back in time. This pre-historic volcanic region is famous for the crater lakes, basalt quarries, slate mines and sandstone cliffs.



The name BITBURG is world known through the local beer which carries the name of the town - "Bitburger Pils". The Bitburger brewery is one of the largest German breweries. The well-known advertising slogan "Bitte ein Bit!", was created in 1951, (the same time as the Bitburg Airbase was built).

The Bitburger brewery sponsored the Benetton Formula 1 Team when Michael Schumacher won two of his seven F1 World Driver's titles (1994 and 1995). The famous Nürburgring motor racing circuit is also within easy reach from Bitburg.
